### Festival Photography Contest

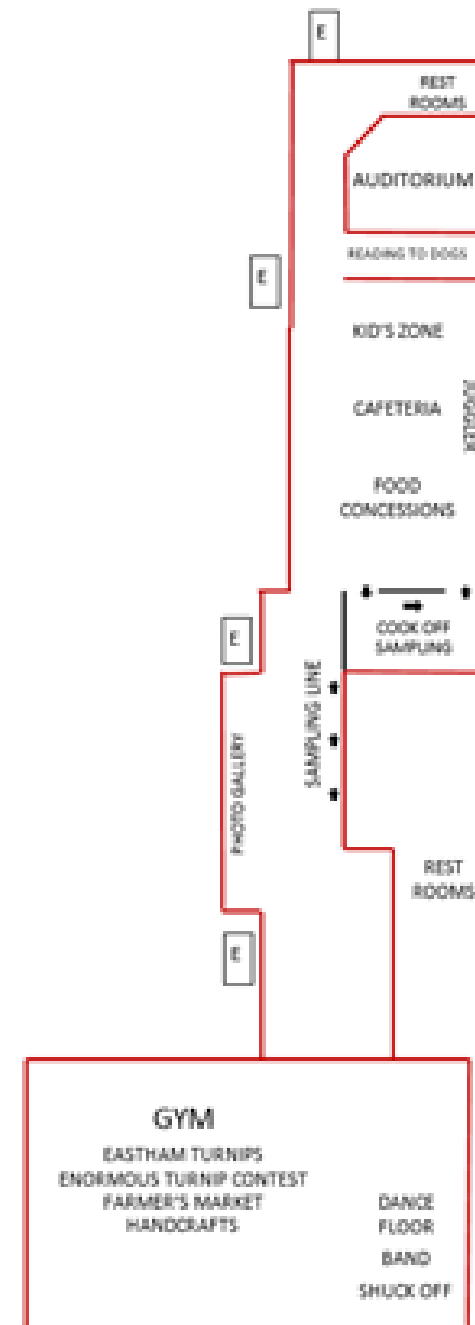

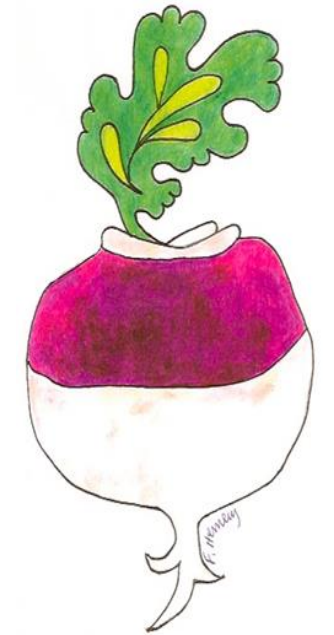
