Whip up an award worthy dish starring the most delectable of all tubers — **the Eastham Turnip** — and win local acclaim! Bake a tried and true turnip recipe featuring turnip ... or create an entirely original turnip taste sensation. Then join the greatest culinary showdown in town!

Registration forms are available at the Eastham Library, or download the form at easthamlibrary.org. A Temporary Retail Food Establishment Permit application, along with copies of a ServSafe certificate and Allergen Awareness Training, must be submitted with a registration form to the Eastham Library (ATTN: Marianne Sinopoli) by Thursday, November 10th.

The rules to enter the Eastham Library's annual **Turnip Cook-Off** are simple:

- Make ANY dish featuring **Eastham Turnip**, appetizer to dessert. LIMIT: No more than 2 entries per food establishment, please.
- Label all dishes with names of the food establishment and cook (address labels work well).
- For hot dishes, provide means to keep the food warm such as a crockpot or insulated casserole tote; transport refrigerated dishes in a cooler.
- Deliver your prepared dish (large enough for 50 or more 2-ounce sample size portions) to the NRHS cafeteria on Festival Day between 10:30 and 12:30 p.m. No need to bring serving utensils. We will provide a Cook-Off Crew to portion/serve your dish and cooks need not be present to win.

PLEASE NOTE: Only licensed food establishments are eligible to enter this contest.
