View from the parking lot

- The Village Improvement Society (VIS)
 Library door is no longer an entrance
- Parking space signs for low emission vehicles and carpool are LEED features
- Rain gardens in between the parking areas help filter water before getting to the pond
- Parking for 51 cars
- Generator (beyond the photo boundaries)






Entrance

- Only public entrance
- Benches
- Wifi
- Bike rack
- Notice the staff and delivery entrance beyond the last column

Lobby (looking straight, slightly left)

- Café seating
- Coffee counter and pantry are to the left of the windows (the windows you see to the left as you look out at the Reading Garden)
- Piano will be behind to the right



Lobby (Looking Slightly Left)

- The restored (Cape-abilities)
 mahogany table will hold
 Friends information
- Entrance into Gregory S
 Turner Meeting Room
- The maple wall on the right will hold the donor sign



Lobby (Looking left)

- The hall from the Lobby to the VIS Library
- Both walls to the right and left house picture rails for art exhibits
- Also to the left is the indoor book return and rest rooms
- Example of acrylic signs (above)







At the end of the red corridor...

VIS Library

- Friends of the Library Book Sale
- Informal Group Meeting Space
- Restoration funded by Community Preservation (CPC) Funds
- Furniture funded by Friends of Eastham Library
- Sparrow Historical Exhibit
- Floor is reclaimed Southern yellow pine
- Ceiling and upper walls are bead board







Exit the VIS Library, on your left is the second entrance to the Meeting Room.

Video Services Coordinator, Mike Caliri is trying out the podium and sound system. This will be the larger of the meeting rooms when the dividing wall is in place.

Upon exiting the Meeting Room...



- Lobby leads through the Café Seating (left by windows)
- In front to the left is the New Book/
 Browsing/DVD and Music CD
 Collections
- In front to the right is the Circulation Desk, Staff Workroom and service entrance





Views of delivery/staff entrance from Lobby

- Receiving area (Friends book donations)
- Café Seating is to the rear

- Grey wall to the right hides the metal grill that separates meeting space from library (after hours)
- Door is entrance into staff work room





Views of Staff Workroom (Located behind Circulation and Self Checkout Desks)

- Left: looking towards Lobby
- Right: looking towards Reading Room
- Staff Work Room also contains area for storage and additional workspace on outside wall



Views of Staff Workroom
(Located behind Circulation and Self Checkout Desks)

- Left: Mail cubbies, storage and work area for volunteers (below windows)
- Right: Special cubbies for processing supplies





Views of Store Room (Adjacent to Staff Workroom/Behind Elevator)

- Left: Sink and countertop for book and DVD repair
- Right: Storage area for Friends book sale/special projects (weeding)





View behind Circulation Desk

- Each bay contains a moveable book truck for sorting/restocking returned books and for materials awaiting patron pickup (Reserve Shelf)
- Notice the mailboxes to the right of the windows

Above: Photocopier/Bulletin Board

Photos on left: New Book/ Browsing




Passing the Circulation Desk and Staff Workroom... Elevator and stairs on the right...



The Reading Room (east)

- Acute angle from inside
- Audiobooks on the right
- Fiction on the left
- Reading chairs, swivel chairs (by window) and reading tables
- Stairs on the right





Reading Room (east) from Windows (acute angle)

- Stairs are to the left
- Stairs, Circulation Desk and Lobby to the left
- Fiction collection towards the rear of photo



Computer Workstations: Walking west and looking at the rear of the library (pond is on the window side)

- Fiction on the right and Non-Fiction on the left
- Window study carrel center rear
- PCs (with ZoomText for Visually Impaired, Macs and screen magnifier



Continuing the walk along the Reading Room, past the Circulation Desk and New Books to the left...

- On the right is the end of the Non-Fiction stacks
- More reading tables
- The Large Print Collection to the left (mobile shelving)

Opposite the reading tables is the Periodicals Room





Periodicals Room (next to the Reading Garden)

- Comfortable reading chairs and tables
- Magazines (storage beneath display shelves)
- Newspapers
- Reference Books

Exiting the Periodicals Room...

Small Conference Room is on the left

To the left is a large wallmounted smart pc and credenza

Tables are AV friendly (wired)







View from Exit (Biographies)






Reading Room West

- Swivel Chairs










Returning to the Reading Room

Lower Level Corridor at the foot of the stairs

To the rear right:

- Electrical Room
- Staff Room
- Eastham Room
- YA Room (Visible to the right)
- Children's Room
- Restrooms (Visible to the left)
- Service Hallway (IT, Custodial, Mechanical Room)
- Elevator





Electrical Room

- Circuit breakers
- Generator controller (Transfer switch)
- Lighting controls
- Cable/Fiber entry from street



Staff Room

- Comfortable seating
- Table and chairs
- Refrigerator, countertop, cabinets, dishwasher (also useful to clean Children's Room toys)
- Picnic table








Eastham Room

- Climate Controlled (humidity) funded by CPC
- Lockable shelving & cabinets
- Custom built maple conference table (Cape Associates) seating 18
- Movable smart pc/ conference equipment
- Windows shades





 First designated space for this age group

• Kids chose some of the furnishings

- Collaborative table
- Swivel chairs
- Rotating CD/DVD units









Entering Children's Room

- Service Desk (not installed), with pond creature chairs/table
- Curved Picture Books on right
- Curved shelving for Fiction(to the right of the pond chairs)









Children's Room

- Curved Sofa (vine pattern)
- Outside view from Program Room
- Family Rest Room (pond creature tile)





Children's Room

- View of patio and benches (newly planted Meadow grass)
- Curved Sofa with view of Depot Pond



Children's Program Room

- Storage (including costumes!), countertop with sink
- Flip 'n Nest tables
- Furniture storage closet
- View left of curved Fiction shelving in Children's Room
- View right of Children's Room Non-Fiction







Leaving the Children's Room...

- Rest Rooms (2)
- Service Corridor (contains mechanical space, custodial closet, IT room)
- Elevator






Leaving the Lower Level...

- Stairs (Notice entrance to electrical room and staff room on left)
- Elevator






Returning to the Main Floor:

- Notice the natural walnut edge on each step






IT (Information Technology)
