

Updated Library hours and conditions of service - August 6, 2021

The Library schedule, which includes modified curb-side on Thursday from 2 – 5 pm and Sunday from 11 am to 2 pm is:

Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday: 10 am – 6 pm Friday, Saturday: 10 am – 1 pm
Sunday & Monday Closed

Patrons two years of age and older must wear masks while inside the library and keep their visits to 30 minutes.

The Library continues to take the COVID-19 seriously and the library is at a reduced 50% capacity of 72. Hand sanitizing stations are available throughout the building. Social distancing is enforced, primarily by greatly reducing the availability of seating in the library. The reserve shelf and self-checkout stations have been moved to allow for more distancing. The email reserve notification system is active, and patrons who prefer curbside service can call the library for an appointment. Meeting rooms and conference rooms are not available. Furniture and equipment is stored in these rooms.

The Youth Services Department offers reduced capacity children's programs outside by the pond. Adult programming can continue via Zoom and is greatly reduced as we provide in-person services.

Sneeze screens have been installed at the public service desks, and air purifiers are located on the children's level and adult staff areas.

The Friends of the Library offer the regular book sale in the VIS Room. Donations are received by volunteers at the book return entrance next to the VIS Room. A volunteer is available to monitor that room.
